Frequently Asked Questions

What will I be doing as an intern in the office of Congresswoman Nydia Velázquez?

Interns assist staff in a wide range of areas including legislative policy work, communications, and administrative assistance. However, it should be noted that the primary responsibilities of the intern will be administrative in nature, meaning answering phones, constituent correspondence, and monitoring incoming mail. Candidates should expect to be given more responsibility over time based on project availability, individual skills, and interest areas. Further, there is opportunity to assist the Congresswoman in her role as Ranking Member of the Small Business Committee.

What is the application deadline?

Spring Session (January – May): December 1 Summer Session (June – August): May 1 Fall Session (September – December): August 1

What materials need to be included in the application?

The application form, resume, cover letter, references, and writing sample must be submitted promptly by the deadline for the term in which you apply. Any application materials submitted after the deadline may result in the rejection of your application.

Are internships paid?

No. All internships are unpaid. Room, board, transportation, and other living expenses are not provided.

May I apply if I am not from New York's 7th Congressional District?

Yes. Preference is given to applicants who are from the District and New York, but all qualified candidates are encouraged to apply.

Can I receive academic credit for completing an internship with the Office of Congresswoman Nydia Velázquez?

Yes if it is allowed by your school. We will provide appropriate related information as requested by your school but arrangements for accreditation should be made before you begin your internship.

Do you accept current students?

Yes. We accept college and graduate students.

Do you accept recent graduates?

Yes. We accept graduates from accredited educational institutions who have demonstrated academic excellence and interest in public service.

How competitive is the process?

The process is highly competitive with the summer session being the most in demand term.
