## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Preserving Cash for
- 5 Transit Access Act of 2021".

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## SEC. 2. SPECIFICATION OF CASH ACCEPTANCE FOR TRANS PORTATION SERVICES.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—As a condition of receiving Fed-4 eral funds, a public benefit corporation providing des-5 ignated public transportation (as such term is defined in section 221 of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 6 7 (42 U.S.C. 12141)) shall accept cash (as such term is de-8 fined in section 602 of the Expedited Funds Availability 9 Act (12 U.S.C. 4001)) as legal tender for any public purchase of transportation services. 10

11 (b) PUBLIC PURCHASE OF TRANSPORTATION SERV-12 ICES DEFINED.—In this section, the term "public pur-13 chase of transportation services" means a purchase of 14 transportation-related expenses at facilities operated by a 15 transportation agency that has, at a minimum—

- 16 (1) booths staffed by transportation agency per-17 sonnel to conduct cash transactions; and
- 18 (2) automated vending machines at transpor-19 tation access points operated by the transit agency.
